FINAL DIAGNOSES

- I. Smoke inhalation and flash fire injury.
 1. Cautery artifact in the airways.
 2. Carboxyhemoglobin level of 24%.
- II. Thermal injury with charring and partial incineration of the body.
- III. Blunt force injuries.
 1. Multiple fractures of the left ribs, including anterior fractures of left ribs 5 through 8, and posterior fractures of left ribs 6 through 11.
 2. Bilateral hemothoraces (100 ml Right and 500 ml Left).
 3. Multiple lacerations of the spleen; hemoperitoneum 50 ml.
 4. Laceration of the left renal artery with retroperitoneal hemorrhage extending to the mesentery.
- IV. Miscellaneous findings.
 1. Diffuse steatosis of the liver.
 2. Obesity.
- V. Additional Diagnoses.
 - A. Postmortem Toxicology - See Attached.
