24	Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settle	ment ("Motion"), having considered all of the
25	submissions and arguments with respect to the M	otion, having provisionally certified by an Order
26	that issued from the bench on August 7, 2006, a S	Settlement Class pursuant to the California Code
27	of Civil Procedure, and GOOD CAUSE APPEAF	RING, the Court finds, orders and adjudges as
28	follows:

This matter satisfies the requirements for the certification of a nationwide class for
 settlement purposes. *7-Eleven Owners for Fair Franchising v. Southland Corp.*, 85 Cal. App. 4th
 1135, 1160-62 (2000); *Dunk v. Ford Motor Co.*, 48 Cal. App. 4th 1794, 1805-06 (1996).

The Court hereby appoints as Class Counsel Jeffrey L. Fazio and Dina E.
 Micheletti of Fazio | Micheletti LLP; Lisa M. Mezzetti of Cohen Milstein Hausfeld & Toll,
 P.L.L.C.; and Jon Tostrud of Cuneo Gilbert & LaDuca LLP.

7 3. Notice to the Settlement Class has been provided in accordance with the proposal 8 described in the parties' Memorandum in Support of Joint Motion for Preliminary Approval of 9 Settlement, and documents submitted in connection therewith, which was approved and adopted 10 by this Court on August 7, 2006, and such notice by mail and via the internet has been given in an 11 adequate and sufficient manner, constitutes the best notice practicable under the circumstances. 12 and satisfies the requirements of due process. The notice apprised the members of the Settlement 13 Class of the pendency of the litigation, of all material elements of the proposed settlement, of the 14 res judicata effect of approval of the settlement on the members of the Settlement Class, and of 15 their opportunity to exclude themselves from the Settlement Class, to object to the settlement, and 16 to appear at the Final Approval Hearing. Full opportunity has been afforded to the members of 17 the Settlement Class to participate in the Final Approval Hearing. Accordingly, the Court determines that all members of the Settlement Class (except those who excluded themselves from 18 19 the settlement) are bound by this Order and Final Judgment. A list of those persons who have 20 excluded themselves from the settlement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

4. The Settlement Agreement was arrived at as a result of arms'-length negotiations
 conducted in good faith by counsel for the parties and is supported by the overwhelming majority
 of the members of the Settlement Class.

5. This case presents difficult and complex issues as to liability and damages as to
which there are substantial grounds for difference of opinion.

26 6. The settlement, as set forth in the Settlement Agreement, is fair, reasonable and
27 adequate in light of the complexity, expense and duration of litigation and the risks involved in
28 establishing liability, damages and in maintaining the class action through trial and appeal.

7. The promises and commitments of the parties under the terms of the Settlement Agreement constitute fair value given in exchange for the releases of the Settled Claims against the Released Parties as those terms are defined in the Settlement Agreement.

The Parties and each Settlement Class Member have irrevocably submitted to the
 jurisdiction of this Court for any suit, action, proceeding or dispute arising out of the Settlement
 Agreement.

9. Any dispute between any Settlement Class Member (including any dispute as to
whether any person is a Settlement Class Member) and any Released Party which in any way
relates to the applicability or scope of the Settlement Agreement or this Order Granting Final
Approval of Settlement and Entering Final Judgment and Order of Dismissal should be presented
exclusively to this Court for resolution by the Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Plaintiffs' Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement is GRANTED.

2. This action is certified as a class action for purpose of settlement on behalf of a Settlement Class consisting of: (1) All persons and entities within the United States and Puerto Rico who own Honda Elements, model years 2003 and 2004, as of the date of this Final Order and Judgment. Excluded from the Settlement Class are the following entities and persons:

A. Honda and its subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors and employees;

B. Persons who have claimed personal injuries as a result of the Windshield Cracking Condition;

C. Persons who have filed separate, non-class legal actions against Honda asserting claims relating to the Windshield Cracking Condition;

D. Persons who have pursued a claim against, and reached a verdict against or settled with Honda from individual claims substantially similar to those alleged in the Complaint;
 E. Persons who claim to have suffered property damage due to the Windshield Cracking Condition (other than a crack in the front windshield);

F. Persons who validly opt out of the settlement.

13	6. By this order and judgment, all members of the Settlement Class have released and
14	do release American Honda Motor Co., Inc., Honda Motor Co., Ltd., Honda R&D Co., Ltd.,
15	Honda R & D Americas, Inc., Honda North America, Inc., Honda of America Mfg., Inc., all
16	Honda related companies involved in the development, design, testing, manufacturing, assembly,
